FAMILY AGREEMENT

We, as parents who are accepting the Biblical principle to *train up a child in the way he should go (Proverbs 22:6)*, place our trust in First Baptist Christian School to extend that training more completely. We agree to work in partnership with the school, pledging our total assistance and support.

_____ We have reviewed the mission and doctrinal statements, educational goals and objectives, discipline procedures and dress code of the school and agree to support and abide by them for the educational and spiritual training of our child(ren) _____ for this coming school year. We further agree that we will cooperate and discipline our child in our home and be available, if needed, if there is a disciplinary problem at the school.

_____ We agree that, if for any reason our child does not respond favorably to the school, we will not seek to alter the Biblical principles under which the school is operating, but will seek to help our child adjust to these principles in his/her own life. _____ If, after consultation with the administration, we are not able to achieve this in a reasonable time, we accept the responsibility to withdraw our child in a spirit of love and cooperation.

_____ We agree to support the school with our prayers and with a positive attitude. Concerns, complaints or negative comments will be shared only with the teacher, administrator or person involved, and not with my child or other people, following the _____ Matthew 18 principle.

_____ We understand that FBCS stands firmly upon the historical truth claims and moral foundations of Christianity. This includes, but is not limited to, the biblical definition of marriage, the attendant boundaries of sexuality and moral conduct, _____ and the clear biblical teaching that gender is both sacred and established by God's design. Parents, or the legal guardians, who choose to enroll their children at FBCS, are agreeing to support these and other basic biblical values derived from historical Christianity. We understand and agree that FBCS will teach these principles and biblical values.

_____ We understand that the School Committee urges parents to recognize their scriptural responsibility (Deuteronomy 6:1-9, Psalm 78:5-6, Proverbs 22:6) to provide their children with a Christian education and to understand that the primary _____ responsibility for this task rests with the parents (Ephesians 6:4). FBCS was founded and continues to operate upon biblical values and the desire and commitment for Bible-believing parents to enroll their children in an intentionally Christian environment. FBCS will consider admission for students from any family who, despite their religious background or beliefs, are willing to support FBCS's philosophy of Christian education, student conduct requirements, and the schools's above-stated positions and who are willing to allow their children to be educated and influenced in an intentionally Christian environment. Public promotion of any lifestyle contrary to the Statement of Faith will not be tolerated. Continued enrollment at FBCS is contingent upon this same understanding and support.

_____ We agree to pay the tuition and fees according to the policies outlined on the Statement of Tuition and to conclude all required payments on or before the last day of school. We understand that report cards and records will be withheld until _____ the obligation has been paid in full.

_____ We understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that our actions do not support the ministry, or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the home and school working together, FBCS has the right to request _____ the withdrawal of our child(ren).
